



19" DOLL APRON AND OVEN MITTS

YARDAGE

Use leftovers from your "Mom and Me Apron" if you'd like the doll's apron & oven mitts to match your child's apron.

Focus Print 1 fat eighth (9" x 21")

Lining 1 fat eighth (9" x 21")

Contrast 1 fat quarter (18" x 21")

Notions thread, 1/2" button (apron), 8" x 8" lightweight batting (oven mitts)

CUTTING

APRON

Focus Print

cut 1 - 7 1/2" w x 8 1/2" h

Lining

cut 1 - 7 1/2" w x 8 1/2" h

Contrast

cut 3 - 1 1/2" x 16" (ties)
cut 1 - 7 1/2" w x 6 1/2" h (pocket)
cut 1 - 2 1/2" x 5" (yoke)

OVEN MITTS

Focus Print and Lining


cut 1 - 8" x 8" each

Contrast

cut 2 - 2" x 6" (binding)

Batting

cut 1 - 8" x 8"



OVEN MITTS


A. Layer the 8" x 8" lining (wrong side up), batting, and 8" x 8" focus print (right side up). Using a walking foot, machine quilt a grid with stitching lines about 3/4" apart.

B. Trace around the template and cut out two mitts.




C. Use the 2" x 6" strips to bind the straight edge of each mitt.

D. Fold each mitt in half wrong side out. Stitch a scant 1/4" seam along the curved edges. Zig-zag along raw edges. Clip up to stitching next to the thumb. Turn the mitts right side out.



Note: On most 19" dolls, the fingers on one hand stick out more so it is harder to get that hand into the mitt.




APRON

Follow the sewing instructions in ATK-176 Mom and Me Aprons, substituting the measurements in the steps below.

Step B Pocket folds to 3 1/4" x 7 1/2".

Step I Stitch 1/8" from the edges.
